How do you want the future of The Message to play out at MSU and in the world? (Winning videos will be played at the conference and grant funds will be awarded for grand prize!)

3) **Resource Fair Table** (\*The proposal deadline is on Monday, November 30, 2009)

Your organization is invited to host a table during the resource fair. This fair is a great opportunity to outreach to current and future student leaders.
